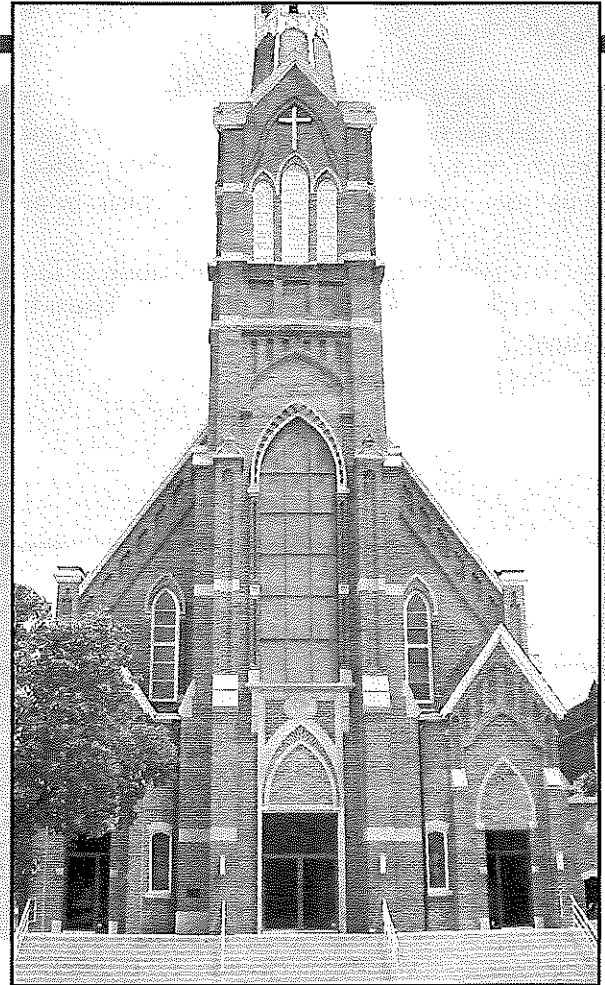
RECONCILIATION Saturday at 3:30 p.m. and by appointment.

Dear Parishioners:

When we are faced with someone like Jesus, someone with a generous heart and a great spirit, our reactions are often filled with jealousy and selfishness. His own people couldn't recognize the holiness of Jesus, because they had never really accepted their own. They couldn't honor his relationship with God because they had never fully explored their own relationship to the Lord. They couldn't see the Messiah standing right beside them, because he looked too much like one of them. Until we see ourselves as people beloved of God, miracles will be scarce.

In today's Gospel, Mark tells us that Jesus was amazed at their unbelief. The most severe critics are often people very familiar to us, a member of our family, a relative, or neighbor. Today's Gospel warns us to be on guard against certain attitudes that are incompatible with the example of Jesus: the human tendency to be possessive, and small in mind and heart. We cannot forget that Jesus is the Savior of the world (John 4:42), and not of the village, town, city or nation!

Let us pray that Jesus will not be amazed at our own unbelief, but rather rejoice in our small, daily acts of fidelity to him and our service to each other. May the Lord grant us generous hearts so that we may look far beyond ourselves and recognize the goodness of other people, instead of being jealous of their gifts. God's power alone can save us from emptiness and poverty of spirit, from confusion and error, and from ourselves.

I pray that everyone enjoyed the celebration of Independence Day and celebrated our freedom to practice our faith. **Turtle Fest will be here before we know it so please contact Amy & Mark Mormon to offer your assistance!**
