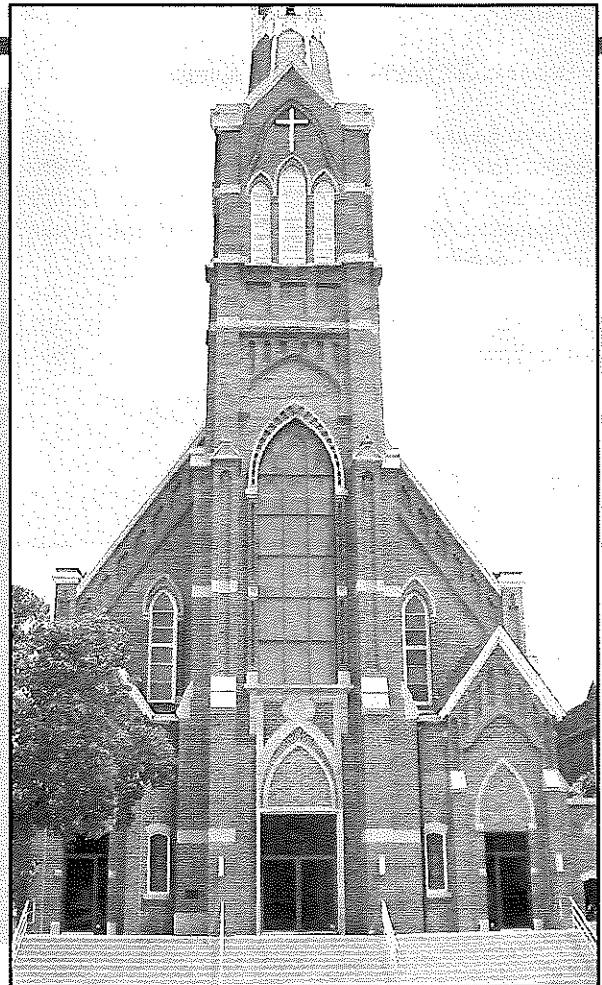
**RECONCILIATION** Saturday at 3:30 p.m. and by appointment.

Dear Parishioners:

The moving Gospel story of Jesus having compassion on the crowds that were "like sheep without a shepherd" helps us to focus on his ministry of teaching, reconciling and shepherding. As your pastor it makes me reflect more deeply on leading the flock entrusted to me toward salvation.

In the New Testament, the image of the shepherd expresses great authority and responsibility. Nourishing the flock means that the shepherd must protect them from false teaching, always ready to defend the sheep.

John tells us that Jesus himself proclaimed: "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep" (John 10:11). Jesus felt gut-wrenching anguish over the souls of these people, who were facing spiritual starvation without someone to feed them, teach them, and lead them to true spiritual nourishment. They were in danger without a shepherd to protect them from false teaching. Like sheep without the good shepherd, they were alone and vulnerable to the attacks of the evil one.

Pope Benedict XVI in his inaugural homily on April 24, 2005 shared these moving thoughts on being a shepherd:

*"The pastor must be inspired by Christ's holy zeal: for him it is not a matter of indifference that so many people are living in the desert. And there are so many kinds of desert. There is the desert of poverty, the desert of hunger and thirst, the desert of abandonment, of loneliness, of destroyed love... The Church as a whole and all her Pastors, like Christ, must set out to lead people out of the desert, towards the place of life, towards friendship with the Son of God, towards the One who gives us life, and life in abundance."*

It is my hope and prayer to provide such leadership, but I need your help in the process. Let us work together to bring the lost back into the fold as we seek to stay on the path of The Good Shepherd.
