Dear Parishioner:

Ephphatha! Be opened! The sigh that came from him at the moment of touching the ears of the deaf man tells us that he identified with the people's sufferings; he participated intensely in their misfortune, made it his burden. Christ's miracles were never an end in themselves; they were signs. **What Jesus once did for a person on the physical level indicates what he wants to do every day for every person on the spiritual level.**

**Though we can hear, we can also be deaf**, to give an example, when we do not hear the cry for help raised to us and we prefer to put between ourselves and our neighbor the "double glaze" of indifference. Parents are deaf when they do not understand that certain attitudes of their children hide a cry for attention and love. A husband is deaf when he cannot see in his wife's nervousness the sign of exhaustion or the need for a clarification. And the same is true for a wife.

**Jesus came to "reconcile us with God" and thus to reconcile us with one another. He does so above all through the sacraments.** The Church has always seen in the seemingly strange gestures that Jesus did with the deaf-mute (he put his fingers into his ears and touched his tongue) a symbol of the sacraments in which he continues "touching" us physically to heal us spiritually. That is why in baptism the minister carries out gestures on the one being baptized as Jesus did on the deaf-mute: He puts his fingers into his ears and touches the tip of his tongue, repeating Jesus' word: "Ephphatha, Be opened!"

The sacrament of **the Eucharist in particular helps us to overcome the inability to communicate with our neighbor**, making us experience the most wonderful communion with God.

**FROM THE SCHOOL**

A study came out recently regarding "Summer Slide". It states that summer learning loss takes a greater toll on students' achievement in math and reading over time, according to an ongoing study by Northwest Evaluation Association (NWEA). By the end of middle school, the study found that students may lose a third of what they learn during the year to summer slide, according to a study summary for Education Week.

"As kids grow less and less during the school years, they are still seeing the same summer drop- so they are losing proportionately more," said Megan Kuhfeld, the study's author. Kuhfeld found both white and black students and those of different income levels lost academic ground over the summer, but overall summer slide, "doesn't seem to be primarily driven by student race, it doesn't seem to be driven by free and reduced-price lunch at the school level." This article was in Success by the Ohio School Boards Association.

Teachers like to get to know their students at the beginning of the year, especially when the teacher is new to the building. Mrs. Krueger had her 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> graders fill out a poster titled It's All About. They answered questions about waking up time, what they do in the morning, afternoon and night, and when they go to bed. They listed 5 Fun Faves such as song, movie, place, color, and memory. They listed their favorite foods at breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

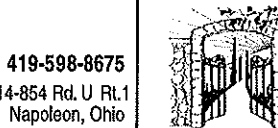
