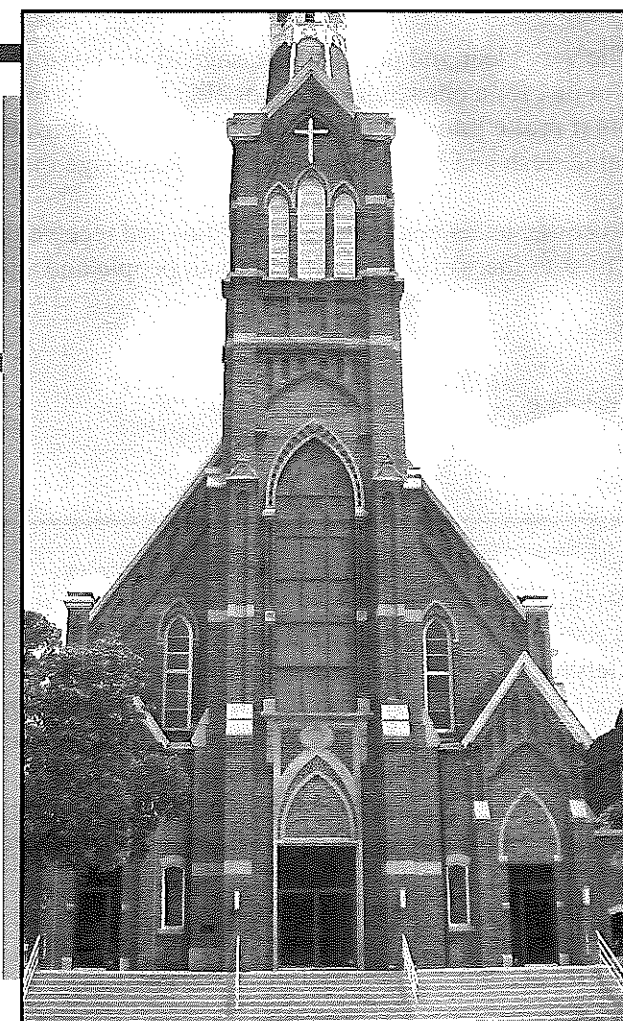
RECONCILIATION Saturday at 3:30 p.m. and by appointment.

The experience of the Magi reminds us that all who make the tedious journey to the truth will finally encounter it and be changed in the process. Saint Odilo of Cluny wrote: "To offer **gold is to proclaim Christ's kingship**, to offer **incense is to adore his Godhead**, and to offer **myrrh is to acknowledge his mortality.**" To this Saint Bruno wrote: "Thus, we offer the Lord gold when we shine in His sight with the light of heavenly wisdom. We offer Him frankincense when we send up pure prayer before Him, and myrrh when, mortifying our flesh... by self-control, we carry the cross behind him."

The word Epiphany means manifestation and is connected with light shining in darkness. The light of Jesus continues to shine in our world and we are called to be strong in the face of the hatred, violence, and darkness that do their best to turn the world from the Light! **When we follow the light and love of God, we may just be led home by another way.**

The very clear and practical message of the Feast of the Epiphany is that it is a feast for all nations. Not just for the Jews. Not just for a chosen few, but for all! **The light of Christ (that star) that was followed by the Magi is a light that we must make known to the world today.** We must take this "Good News" to the nations that Jesus, the Son of God, became flesh and lived among us. It is a message that calls us all into action.

So come, let us continue to adore Him and receive the fire of God's love. Let us all do our part to proclaim the light of Christ to the world. A light sent to all people and all nations!

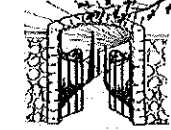
