This week we recognized Red Ribbon Week. This year's theme is "Be Happy. Be Brave. Be Drug Free." Red Ribbon Week is an alcohol, tobacco, drug and violence prevention awareness campaign observed annually in October. It began as a tribute to fallen DEA special agent Enrique Camerena, in 1985. Each day was themed with a special message. Monday was "Stay Bright and Sock It to Drugs" where students wore crazy socks and learned about poison control. Tuesday was "Don't Get Mixed Up in Drugs" and wore crazy mismatched clothes then discussed how to avoid drugs.
