PRINCIPAL'S NOTE

Welcome back! The first two weeks of school are in the books. Next week our Kindergarten through 8th grade students will begin to take the Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) test. The MAP test is a computerized adaptive test offered in Reading, Language Usage, and Math providing St. Augustine educators with information to improve teaching and learning. The difficulty of each question is based on how well a student answers all the previous questions. It is important to understand that the MAP test is one test at one point in time. It does not measure intelligence or a student's capacity for learning. When making important decisions about students, we will consider the MAP test results along with other data such as classroom performance, other test scores, additional assessments, and input from parents and teachers.

FAMILY HANDBOOK

Our new 2021-22 St. Augustine School Family Handbook (Kindergarten through 8th grade) was sent home last week. Please review it, sign the acknowledgement form and return to the school office. There have been many changes, so be sure to review it carefully.
