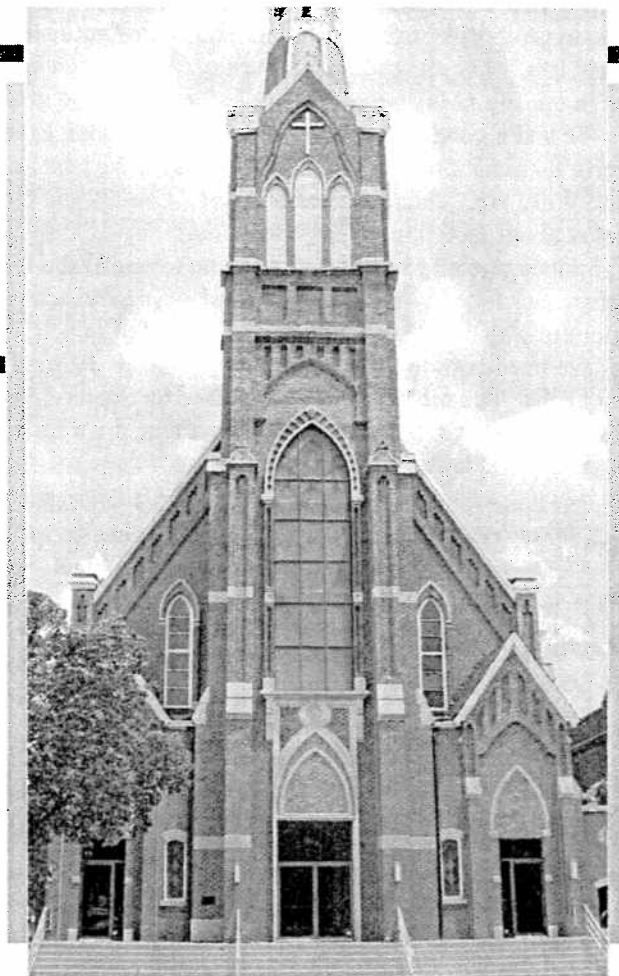

The Magi Follow the Star and Find Jesus

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord. This feast celebrates Jesus being revealed to the strangers, the magi, who came from the East. They are led by a star to Bethlehem to encounter the newborn king. When they see Jesus, they prostrate themselves out of reverence for Him and offer their gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh.

On their journey to find Jesus, the magi also encounter King Herod. He is fearful of this news about a newborn king. He pretends that he also wants to go and pay homage to Jesus. However, Herod wants to destroy any threat to his earthly power.

Christmas reveals to us that Jesus is born into our world. Jesus is Emmanuel, meaning "God-with-us." In life we face the constant journey to discover Christ and to allow Him to be a part of our life. We, like the Magi, also face the forces in our world that seek to keep us from finding Christ.

May the feast of the Epiphany help us to see Christ in our life. May we humbly offer our gifts to the Lord. May He guide us to happiness in this life and eternal joy in heaven.

January 9 – 15 is National Vocation Awareness Week. The Diocese of Toledo Vocations Office says, "This week is a reminder to all of us to live the vocational call we received at baptism. It is also a week to pray especially for religious vocations in our church. The Office of Vocations asks you to join in praying for this intention."

I am including a prayer by Thomas Merton that I encourage you to use this week.

My Lord God, I have no idea where I am going. I do not see the road ahead of me. I cannot know for certain where it will end. Nor do I really know myself, and the fact that I think that I am following your will does not mean that I am actually doing so. But I believe that the desire to please you does in fact please you. And I hope I have that desire in all that I am doing. I hope that I will never do anything apart from that desire. And I know that if I do this you will lead me by the right road, though I may know nothing about it. Therefore will I trust you always, though I may seem to be lost and in the shadow of death. I will not fear, for you are ever with me, and you will never leave me to face my perils alone.

The Confirmation Retreat is next Sunday, January 15. Please include the Confirmation students in your prayers as they continue to prepare for this Sacrament.


