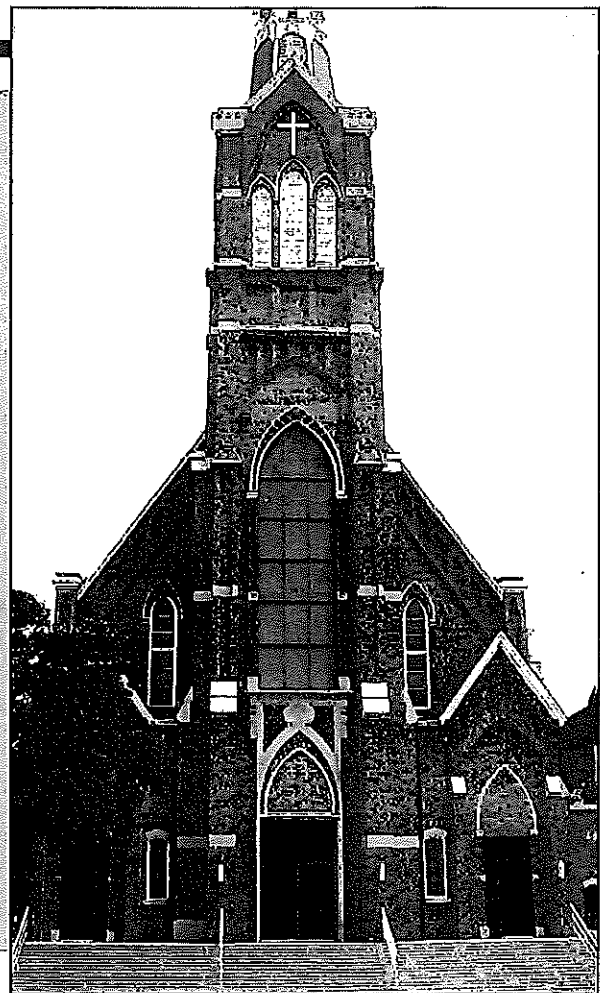

Dear Parishioners:

The people in Jesus' "native place" cannot see how someone they know and knew as a young man could do the things He was doing. His own people couldn't recognize the holiness of Jesus, because they had never really accepted their own. They couldn't see the Messiah standing right beside them, because he looked too much like one of them. Until we see ourselves as people beloved of God, miracles will be scarce.

In today's Gospel, Mark tells us that Jesus was amazed at their unbelief. The most severe critics are often people very familiar to us, a member of our family, a relative, or neighbor. Today's Gospel warns us to be on guard against certain attitudes that are incompatible with the example of Jesus: the human tendency to be possessive, and small in mind and heart. We cannot forget that Jesus is the Savior of the world (John 4:42), and not of the village, town, city or nation!

Let us pray that Jesus will not be amazed at our own unbelief, but rather rejoice in our small, daily acts of fidelity to him and our service to each other. May the Lord grant us generous hearts so that we may look far beyond ourselves and recognize the goodness of other people, instead of being jealous of their gifts. God's power alone can save us from emptiness and poverty of spirit, from confusion and error, and from ourselves. Have a happy and safe 4th of July!

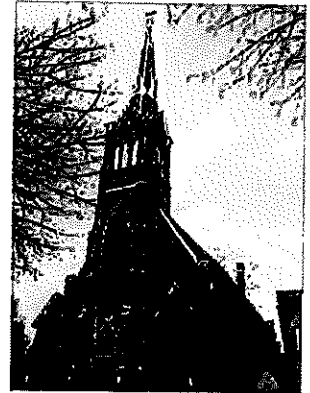

Dear Mr. Otto,


Let me express my gratitude to you, the members of the Board, and all who work in our local schools to advance the learning and growth of our young people. We live in a time that has its specific challenges in education, but when we all work together it is our students that will all benefit from any extracurricular and academic opportunities, particularly when it comes to release time.

Please know of my concern regarding LifeWise Academy that is planned for this next school year. Other pastors along with me are concerned about the curriculum and being informed late in the process of the planning. I have 1st Amendment concerns about basically two churches in town operating the program and stating it is "not associated with a specific church." They are not aligned with Catholic teaching on the Sacred Scriptures, nor with Lutheran or other mainline Protestant churches. The issue is allowing two churches in town to have full access to all our children and teaching things contrary to the Catholic Church, in the case of my parishioners. In their promotional video shown at the "community meeting" a LifeWise teacher said: "Austin came to my room in 1st grade, and now he comes to my church."

The history of Catholic Schools in the U.S. tells, in a large part, they came into being because the Public Schools were basically Protestant schools that persecuted Catholic students and others for their faith. With this program, I fear history repeating itself with a new twist. Christian education is very important when it comes to values, morality, and the Bible, but it belongs in the churches of Napoleon! We all need to work together and make this happen, but you cannot show preference to one or two churches to the exclusion of others.

With this in mind, I ask for our own release time for the students who belong to St. Augustine Catholic Church and any others who would seek Christian instruction. I look forward to having the same consideration that has been granted to others as we seek a convenient place in the schedule for us and the school.

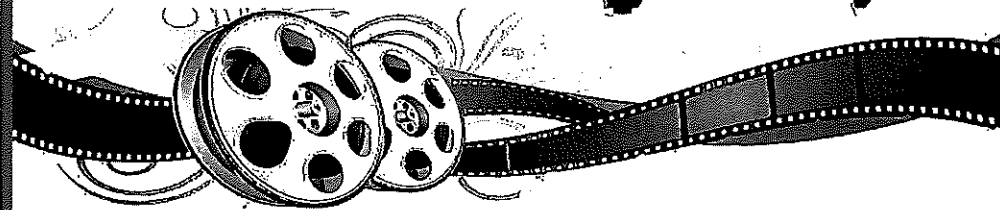

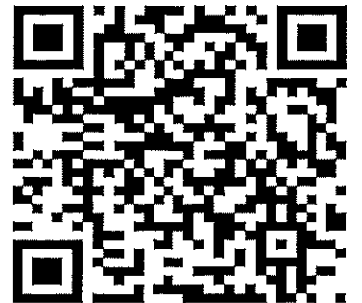
