**RECONCILIATION** Saturday at 3:30 p.m. and by appointment.

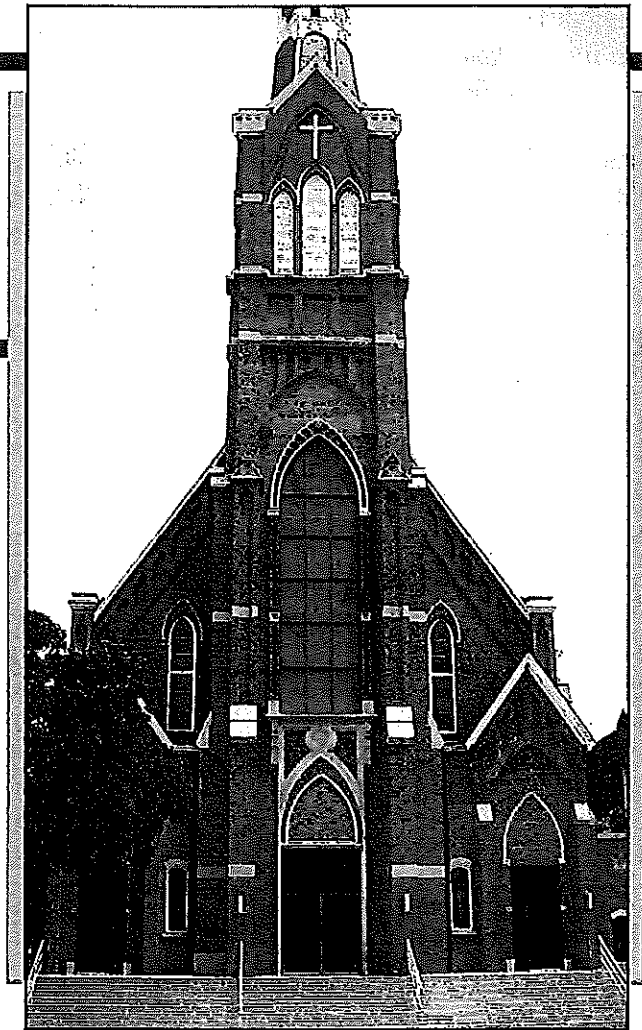

Dear Parishioners:

St. Maximilian Kolbe said: "If angels could be jealous of men, they would be so for one reason: Holy Communion." This is the time we are called to proclaim publicly as Saint John Paul II said that "the sacrifice of Christ [offered in the Eucharist] is for the salvation of the whole world."

By the miracle of loaves and fishes, Jesus in today's Gospel again prefigures the blessings of the Eucharist. Notice that He takes the bread, blesses it, breaks it, and gives it to the Twelve.

The Eucharist fulfills the offering of Melchizedek in the First Reading. It is the daily miracle of the heavenly high priesthood of Jesus. It is a priesthood He conferred upon the Apostles in ordering them to feed the crowd, in filling exactly twelve baskets with leftover bread, in commanding them on the night He was handed over: "Do this in remembrance of Me."

Through His priests He still feeds. And by this sign He pledges to us a glory yet to come. For as often as we share in His body and blood, we proclaim His victory over death, until He comes again to make His victory our own.

With this being my second to last bulletin letter, one of my continued and final prayers for the people of St. Augustine would be for a deeper and more loving reverence of Christ present in the Eucharist!
