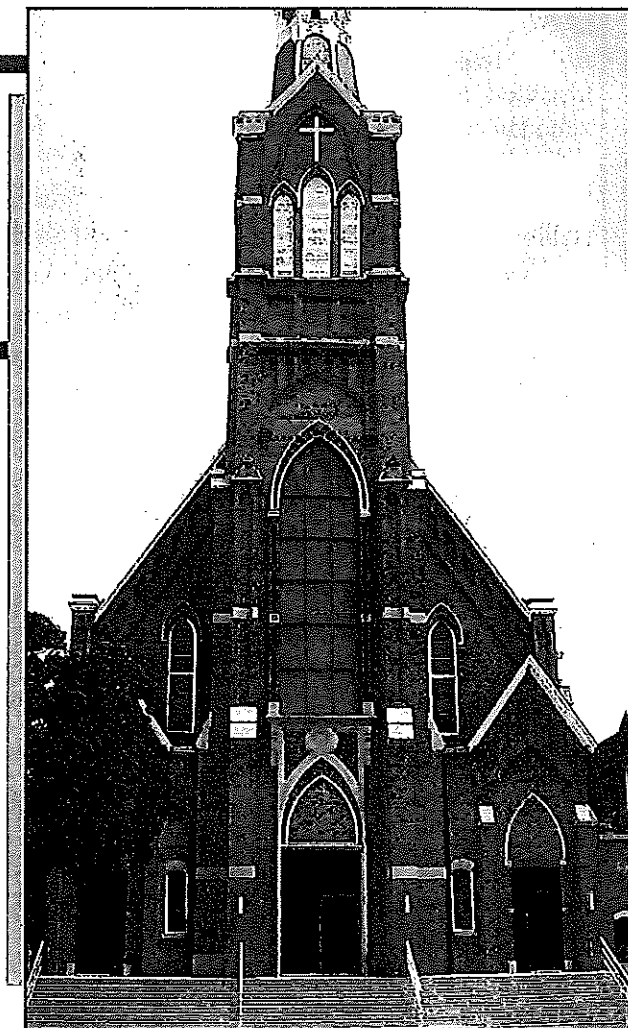

Padre' Jerry's Notes: I find myself relying on others, is that good or bad?

When we travel a lot we find ourselves relying often on others because we may find the need for assistance and comfort. In the olden days, before a lot of restaurants and inns, people relied on the hospitality of strangers. An up right person would be expected to provide for other's needs. Abraham and Sarah fulfilled this expectation and then some when they encountered three strangers traveling by in today's 1st. reading. Their faith taught them to see the presence of the Lord in all people. So, it was about God's presence that was manifested when they welcomed the strangers with their hospitality.

We have to be able to first accept God's love so as to give God's love. After understanding and accepting God's love for us, we can then begin to love others like God has loved us. The Bible gives us a couple of guidelines for how to love others: **Be a Friend** – Proverbs 17:17 says, "A friend loves at all times, and a brother is born for a time of adversity" At times it seems we love others best, but we love God the most. The reason we will love others best when we love God most is that love in its truest, purest form only comes from God, because God is love (1 John 4:7-8). Love is a fundamental part of his nature. And so it is a fundamental part of our nature.

In the spirit of Valentine's Day, I was once thinking of different ways I could be showing God's love to others. While Hallmark and the rest of the commercialized world want you to believe that Valentine's Day is only for couples and love is only for romantic relationships, I beg to differ. Valentine's Day is about celebrating love and caring... so with its Christian origin, it's about sharing God's love, too. When we help one another and when we rely on one another it's sharing and offering God's love. Yes, it appears Martha is trying to show that same hospitality when welcoming Jesus into her home. We serve others by our reaching out to others, especially those who are in need.

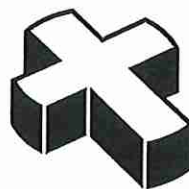
