**What are the consequences of Original sin?** Some years ago the London Times asked the question...  
**“What’s Wrong With The World?”** A Catholic convert Gilbert Chesterton, wrote the briefest reply: *Dear Sirs: I am. Sincerely Yours, G.K. Chesterton.*

Yes, no one is perfect. An honest look at our own experience reveals we are sinners all. Why is this so? Were we always sinners? The Book of Genesis gives us the answer. This first book tells us the history of the Fall of Man in the language of imagery. God created man and endowed with intelligence, love, freedom, and conscience. He gave them the grace of original holiness that made it possible for them to be friends with him. They began in grace, not sin. That friendship was tested by forbidding them to eat of the tree of knowledge. He said, “the moment you eat of it, you are surely doomed to die”. What did the test mean? The tree symbolized the limits of humans as creatures. We should depend on and be subject to God’s moral laws which govern our freedom. God was tasting the use of human freedom. Freedom is the results of our many choices and disobedience results in our sin. It is the characteristic of all sins. I would rather do it my way. The results leave us from God’s graces.

It was St. Augustine who coined the term “original sin” to refer to the impact of sin of our first parents on us. It caused the death of the body. It also caused the wounds of human nature. St. Thomas Aquinas speaks of these four wounds as (1) ignorance, meaning difficulty in knowing truth and loss of confidence that it can be known; (2) malice in the mind, inclining us to uncharitable motives; (3) weakness in the will, making it difficult to choose goodness; (4) disorder in our passions and emotions, causing us to lose control of ourselves. Yes, we are sinners, but we don’t commit original sin... we only commit actual sin. It’s the effects of sin that we are born with that alienates us from God. Baptism gives us back the grace and restores our friendship with God. God does not abandon... God restores. – Fr. Jerry
