The Solemnity of The Most Holy Trinity...

Yes, the Trinity is a great mystery of the Faith, but it's also a great gift of love... The love of God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. The great mystery of One God, made up of three persons sharing one divine substance... the Trinity. It's through God's self-revelation to us through Jesus Christ and his Paschal Mystery, that we come to know the Triune God from whom all life flows. God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life. When Jesus left us, this world, he gave us an advocate to be with, Holy Spirit, the third person of the Trinity. God proclaims himself as the gracious, merciful, loving God. In John's Gospel today; God gave the world his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him... might have eternal life. St. Paul instructs the community to live in encouragement, agreement, love, and peace, and ends in a blessing of the Trinity.

Next Sunday is Corpus Christi Sunday...

The Eucharist is the source and summit of the whole Christian life. The feast of Corpus Christi is a celebration of Christ's Real Presence in the Eucharist. It parallels the celebration on Holy Thursday in commemoration of the institution of this sacrament. Next Sunday the Eucharist is carried through the streets in solemn procession, the Christian people give public witness of their faith and devotion toward the sacrament of the Eucharist. In faith we acknowledge Jesus' true presence.

The Sacrament of the Eucharist is a sign and cause of the unity of Christ's Mystical Body, because it stirs up an active "ecclesial" spirit in those who are more fervent in their Eucharistic devotion. Eucharistic adoration cannot be detached from the liturgical and communal celebration of the sacrament or from the commitment to the poor and to justice. One draws strength and justification from the other. We process after the 10:30 Mass out the front doors and around the block. We conclude back in the Church with closing Benediction. Please plan on joining us. - Fr. Jerry

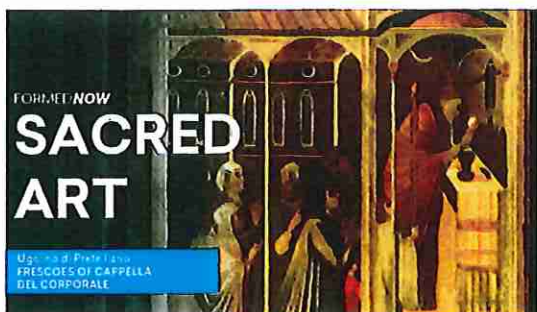
