

## Eucharistic Revival... "This Is My Body"

Jesus, truly is the source and summit of who we are and our faith in understanding it. Through the generosity of our local Knights of Columbus we are extending to all our families a new book out from Word on Fire and Bishop Robert Barron, who is in some minds arguably the greatest Catholic communicator of our times on matters of our faith. Feel free to pick up a copy, "This is my Body" (for FREE) in the back of church. You may, as the phrase goes... "Pass It On" after you have read it, as they also say, anything good is meant to be shared.

The book was written to give us a deeper understanding that the Eucharist is as a Sacred meal, and the Eucharist is as a Sacrifice, and that it is not a symbol but truly what Jesus said... "This is my Body... This is my Blood" "I am the Bread of Life... I am the living bread which came down from heaven; if any one eats of this bread, he will live forever... this is my flesh" John 6:47, 51.

In his farewell discourse at the Last Supper, Jesus promised his disciples and us: I will not leave you desolate; I will come to you. Picking up on this theme Pope St. John Paul II said, In every celebration of the Eucharist, his coming, his salvific presence, and is sacramentally realized: in the Sacrifice and in the Communion. — Fr. Jerry
