

Today's readings teach us about the word of God. Three characteristics stand out.

First the word of God is expansive. The prophet Isaiah offers a beautiful image of the word of God coming down from heaven like rain and snow, with enough strength to nourish the whole world. Like rain and snow, God's word gets to work sparking new growth to all who encounter it.

Second, it is contextual. The gospel parable of the sower and seeds, Jesus gives us options for where the seed lands – an image of how people can receive God's word. We have a variety of ways people encounter the word from not receiving it all, to finding great joy but not sustaining it, to experiencing life's temptations and not being able to take it in.

Finally, both Isaiah and Jesus show the connection between the word of God and nature. They both use nature imagery - for it is not stuck somewhere in the heavens out of reach. Rather the word is all around us, ready to be discovered and engaged.

Spend some prayerful time in nature this week and listen to God's revelation.






