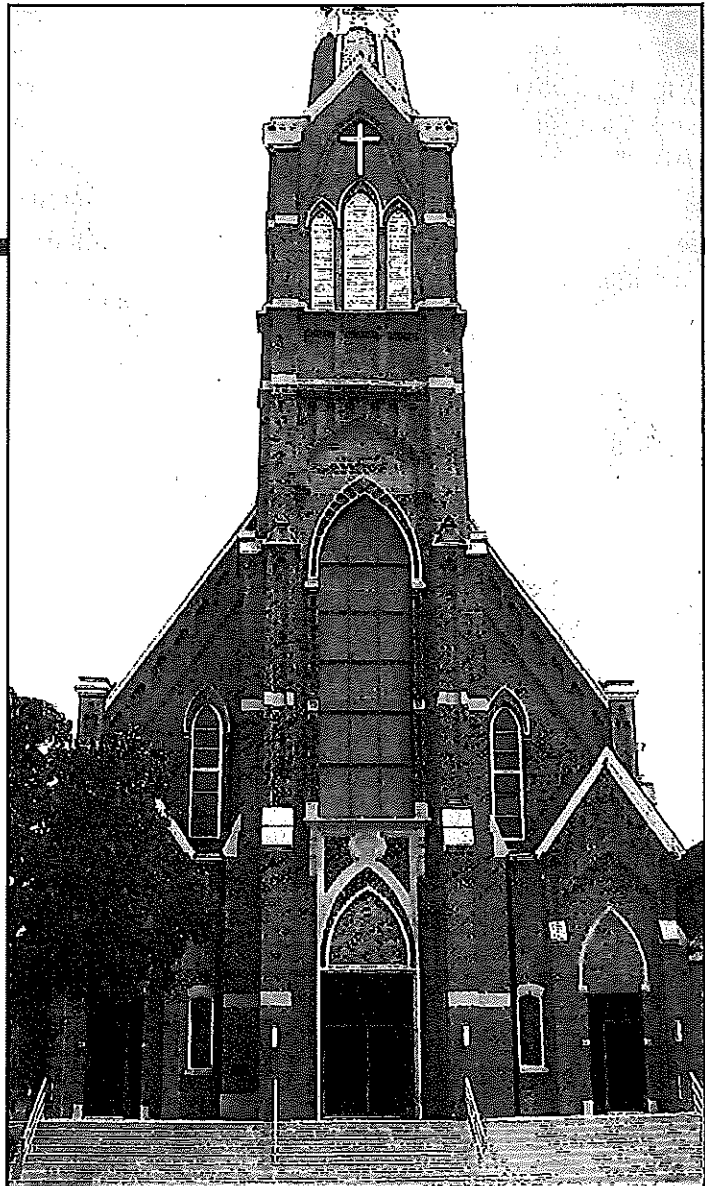

Many in our society are the foreigners - Faith Building brings them to understanding...

Coming to worship the God of Israel, we stand in the line of faith epitomized by the Canaanite woman in today's Gospel. Calling to Jesus as Lord and Son of David, this foreigner shows her great faith in God's covenant with Israel. Jesus came first to restore the kingdom to Israel. But His ultimate mission was the reconciliation of the world, as Paul declares in today's Epistle. Our mission is to too carry on the mission. In the Mass we join all peoples in doing Him homage. As Isaiah foretold, we come to His holy mountain, the heavenly Jerusalem, to offer sacrifice at His altar. With the Canaanite, we take our place at the Master's table to be fed as His children. We learn and grow by faith; teach and bring others to Christ.

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is a process for bringing into the Catholic Church both those who have never been baptized and those who were baptized in a non-Catholic church. RCIA is also the best way for adult Catholics who have never been confirmed to prepare for that final Sacrament of Initiation. It's an extra opportunity to learn and grow in faith... with no outside force. We will begin a new RCIA class Wednesday nights starting in late September and we invite everyone who would like to join the Catholic Church, be confirmed, or anyone who is simply interested in learning about the teachings and customs of Catholic Christianity to come and join us. RCIA is more than a class; it is a gradual introduction to the customs, beliefs, practices, and devotions of Catholicism as well as developing a personal relationship with our Lord. There is no obligation - there is No cost only an opportunity to learn. We hope you will join us! RCIA meets on most Wednesdays from September through April in the Ministry Center from 6:30 - 8:00pm. 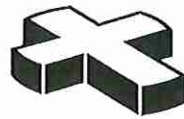


LIFE TEEN

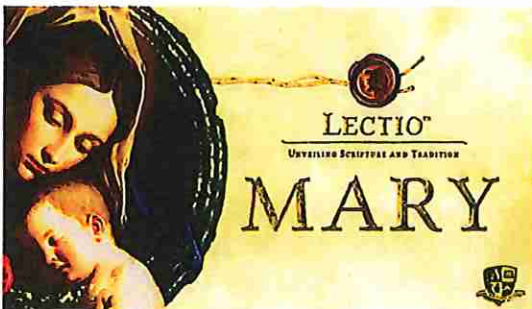

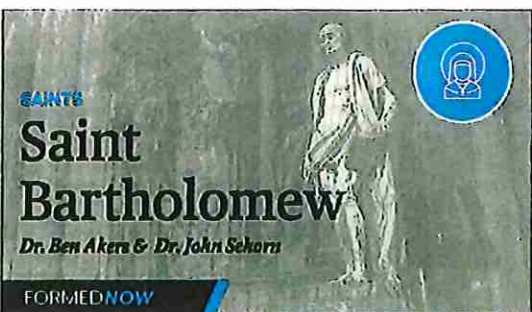

MARRIAGE "As soon as a couple makes a decision to marry and at least six months before the anticipated wedding date they are to make contact with the priest/deacons in order to begin the various steps of the Marriage Preparation Program" (Diocese of Toledo Directive).
