

Long Range Goals...

We all tend to have long-range goals. These are actually what assist us through the tough times. We accept a job because we see possibilities for advancement. We plan ahead for retirement so we can live in relative comfort without worry. Goals are the stuff of human achievements like having a positive mindset and developing self confidence. Spiritual goals open our minds to God's plan for us.

Lenten goals and objectives are one of the main things people focus on during Lent. The typical three are Prayer — Fasting — Alms Giving, being the person God wants of us. But goals are also to change us. We can read spiritual books, scriptures, and take part in meditations. We can come to realization of our faults and experience freedom from our sins through God's gift of forgiveness. Another good goal is to remember the love of God that is poured out through Christ Jesus on the Cross... His death and resurrection, we can walk with him this Lenten season in the Stations of the Cross.

Moriah... the mountain of sacrifice, is where the test of Abraham is subjected to. Though Genesis reports that Abraham built many altars throughout the Promised Land, Moriah is the only place the text tells us that he actually offered sacrifice, he sacrificed a ram instead of his son. This weekend the disciples go where Jesus goes... to the mountain of transfiguration. On the way to the mountain where glory is revealed, however, there are other mountains to ascend and descend, the mountain of testing and the mountain of dying. Being tested, hardships, loss, temptation, human weakness, facing death are seen as low points. Spiritually, the image of mountain indicates these can be high points, moments along the journey to ultimate transfiguration, the moments of changing us. Our paths (goals) can be marked as Green – for easiest, Blue – for medium difficult, and Black – for most difficult. – Fr. Jerry





MARRIAGE "As soon as a couple makes a decision to marry and at least six months before the anticipated wedding date they are to make contact with the priest/deacons in order to begin the various steps of the Marriage Preparation Program" (Diocese of Toledo Directive). Official dates for wedding celebrations at St. Augustine Parish must be approved by the Pastor or Parish Deacon.
