

Hope in Forgiving... "Seventy Times Seven"...

That means 490 times, an extremely large number almost a number beyond comprehension.

They say... "A man has a heart as big as all outdoors... while a woman has a heart of gold". So, Jesus' message of forgiving is from the heart. Many see "forgiveness" as a word and action that is hard to do; sometimes we even doubt that we can be forgiven. But, God is always ready to forgive... just as we should be ready to forgive. Trusting in Jesus' forgiveness we can trust in our ability to forgive.

Although we cannot properly forgive others without understanding the concept of forgiveness and its importance, that intellectual knowledge is not, of course, forgiveness itself.

If we are to move from understanding forgiveness to granting it, we must move from the mind to the "heart"... from simply accepting the idea of forgiveness to embracing it and making it truly a part of us. In other words, we must move beyond an understanding of forgiveness to an attitude of forgiveness. Our heart knows we are gaining something by forgiving, while the mind can resist forgiveness because it feels like it's giving up something owed. It's the heart that adds the love, understanding and patience to stick with the intention.

Saint Bonaventure stated, "Three things are necessary to everyone: truth that brings understanding, love of Christ which brings compassion, and endurance of hope which brings perseverance."

While Lent is traditionally the season to renew and refocus our discipleship through deeper experience of forgiveness, it is important to remember that Christians are also called to live in hope. This Lent let us work to become more understanding, compassionate, and faithful through developing a habit of forgiving and seeking forgiveness. — Fr. Jerry


