CAFETERIA CHARGING

After May 3rd, we will no longer allow students to charge on their lunch account; they must have a credit on their account in order to purchase lunch. This will allow us to close out the cafeteria account at the end of the school year. Please have your account up-to-date by then.

2024-25 REGISTRATION

Please help us in our enrollment process by re-registering your child in OptionC. On your home page, choose "Registration" from the "Office" drop down menu. After confirming the information in the "Re-registration Student Form" (and then clicking on "Save" at the bottom), select the box under "Register Next Year?", then Click on "Submit Student Registration" at the bottom.

Students entering Kindergarten - 8th Grade are eligible to receive an EdChoice Scholarship for the 2024-25 school year. If your child received an EdChoice Expansion Scholarship in our current school year, you are only required to fill out the EdChoice Scholarship Program Renewal Form and supply a current utility or gas bill that includes both the Mailing Address and Service Address to verify residency.



STUDENT COUNCIL STORE

Our Student Council will provide a store for your child to purchase snack items each morning from 8:00 until 8:15 in the school gym. They will offer this service from April 22nd - May 3rd. Funds raised will be used for end-of-the-year activities sponsored by the Student Council.
