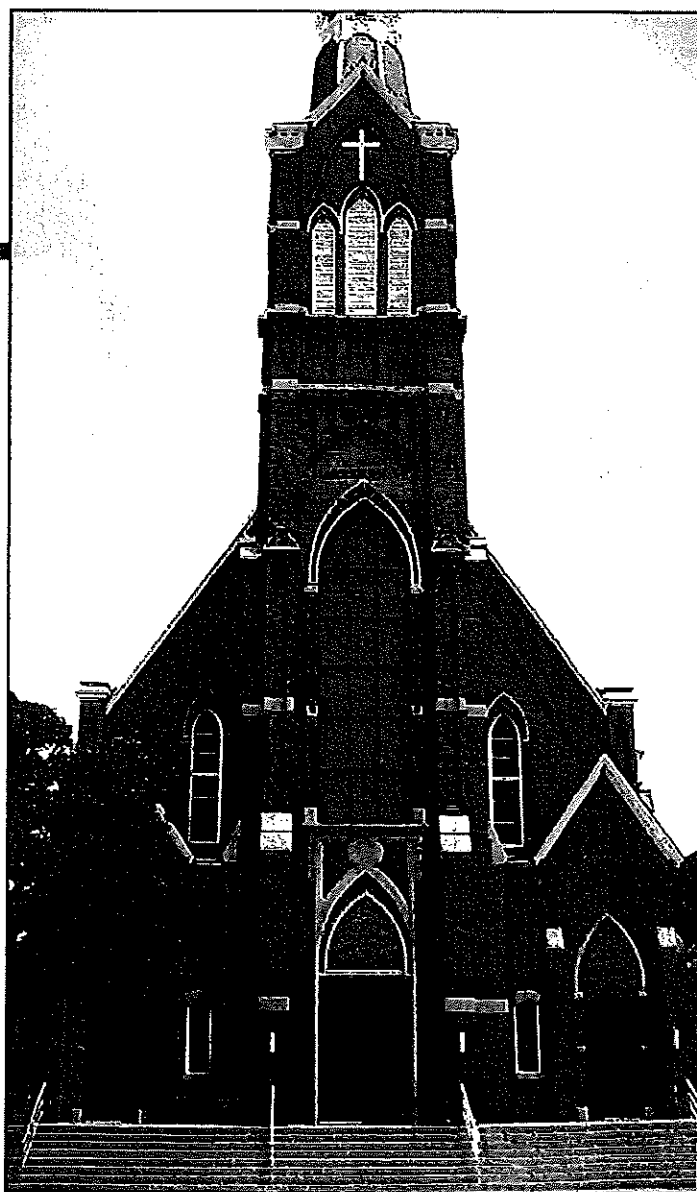

How Real IS the Real Presence?

This presence is *called real*... by which it is not intended to exclude the other types of presence... but because it is the presence in the fullest sense: that is to say, it is a "*substantial presence by which Christ, God and man, makes himself wholly present*" CCC 1374

It has often been known to be said: "*I could not do this without spending time each day before the Holy Eucharist*". One will draw from the graces one receives by being in the *True Presence*. Chapter six of John's Gospel records Christ's dialogue at the Capernaum Synagogue when He speaks about the Bread of Life. He had just finished filling them with the natural bread now he was to fill them with something new; the Spiritual Bread of Life, His body and blood... so as to have eternal life. Here and hereafter.

I know many say he was only speaking metaphorically, but Jesus emphasized the truth of his statement, eight times as he repeats the statement... **I am the Living Bread!** Quit thinking in human senses, but think Spiritually. He did not soften the words or correct himself, accept to say that... It is the Holy Spirit that give life. Many think we can leave because we find it hard to believe... *but where can we go*, as Peter said. Yes, we all know that Judas didn't really believe because he would later betray him. So in a sense not believing is betraying.

Throughout history the Fathers of the Church all have affirmed the **Real Presence** of Jesus in the Eucharist. After the prayers of consecration are said by the priest... the bread **IS** the **BODY** of **CHRIST** and wine **IS** the **BLOOD** of **CHRIST**. There is a big word for this... it is called **transubstantiation**. It's all by faith and the Holy Spirit... and the Divinity of Jesus Christ that this happens. The bread still looks like bread and the wine still tastes like wine, but their *reality has changed*. Yes, faith alone can see and belief alone can realize. As I lift up the Eucharist, I see Jesus... and Jesus sees me and my blood rushes to my head. Yes, I look at Jesus and he looks at me. That is a Spiritual reality that no one should want to let go of.

Jesus wanted us to have the memorial of the love with which he loved us... yes, to the end. In his Eucharistic presence he remains mysteriously in our midst as one who loved us and gave himself up for us. Jesus awaits us in this sacrament of love. Let us never refuse, yes, never refuse the time to go to meet him in adoration, in contemplation full of faith, and open to making amends for the serious offenses and crimes of the world. - Fr. Jerry

Let us Pray... *Eucharistic Jesus, I adore you with all my heart you are truly present for me, in contemplating you all else fades away. Increase my love of you, others, and self. Amen*
