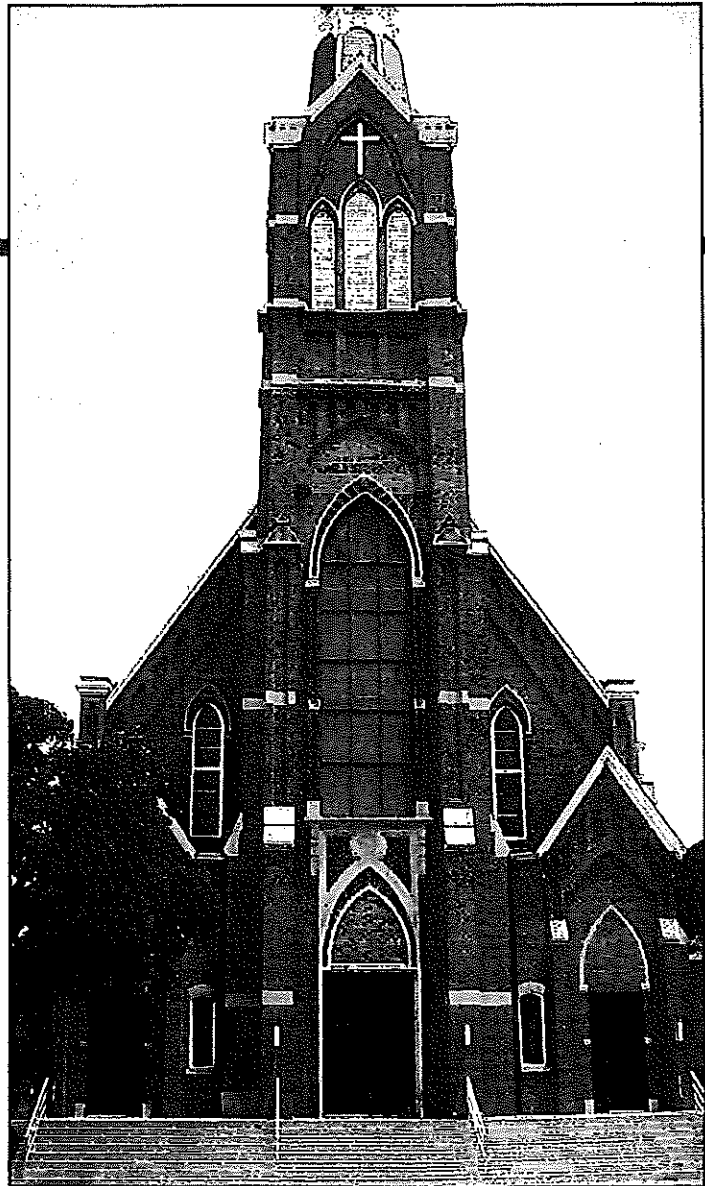

## Body Building for the Soul...

You may know the old saying... "No Pain No Gain!" So what do you do to succeed in the gym? You gradually add more resistance. Yes, every pound you add, every lap you run becomes a new obstacle to overcome. As you progress through your regimen, your muscles grow stronger; your lungs increase in capacity, your physical appearance changes. What's the reward? You feel great about your body! You feel great about yourself!

Every one of us suffers from some sort of addiction. For some, it might be a television series, or an extra piece of pie, while others struggle with a crippling reliance on drugs or alcohol, and at times sexual frustrations. The cycle of dependency always leaves you wanting more; you are never satisfied no matter how much you indulge. If you are ready to break the unfulfilling cycle and experience internal freedom, we must exercise our inner selves.

To survive the tidal wave of compulsive behavior and addiction, we as Catholic Christians... must learn "to breathe under water" and discover God's love and compassion. We can only be healed and find true fulfillment by facing our dependencies head-on.

Jesus was a great teacher for us and one of the most important lessons he left us was the example of resisting the temptation. He gave us the example of what to say and warns us that things will cause us to sin. Jesus knows temptation occurs in everyone's life. But we have to make good habits and break bad habits. It's true! The devil loves an idle mind and lifestyle. Staying active so as not let his temptations to overcome us.

I was once told this trick by a realtor trying to sell my house. He encouraged me, "Just before a potential buyer shows up, put a tray of cookies in the oven timed to be done the minute they walk in the door". This isn't about removing objections they might have about the house. No! His plan was that I would be appealing to a hidden urge and craving to feel comfortable in this setting... the buyer was entering. A pleasing aroma and a taste no one can resist, a warm freshly baked cookie, ah, they'll mask anything.

In life that same masking happens... could it be the devil? He uses this same cooking secret to lure us into sin? He even tried so with Jesus... "Change these rocks into loaves of bread". Through temptation, he creates the aroma of pleasure and satisfaction that can sure feel good. When you are tempted, you may know that what you are about to do is wrong, and you may even battle your own conscience in the process, but, because it makes you feel so good, your objections disappear. When you succumb to temptation, you convince yourself that sin isn't just something you are considering. It's something that, at least for the moment, you are comfortable with. Wait though; when you let temptation lead you to sin, there is nothing wonderful about the after-taste... or the leftovers. Remember, the tempter in reality is not a very good cook. - Fr. Jerry
