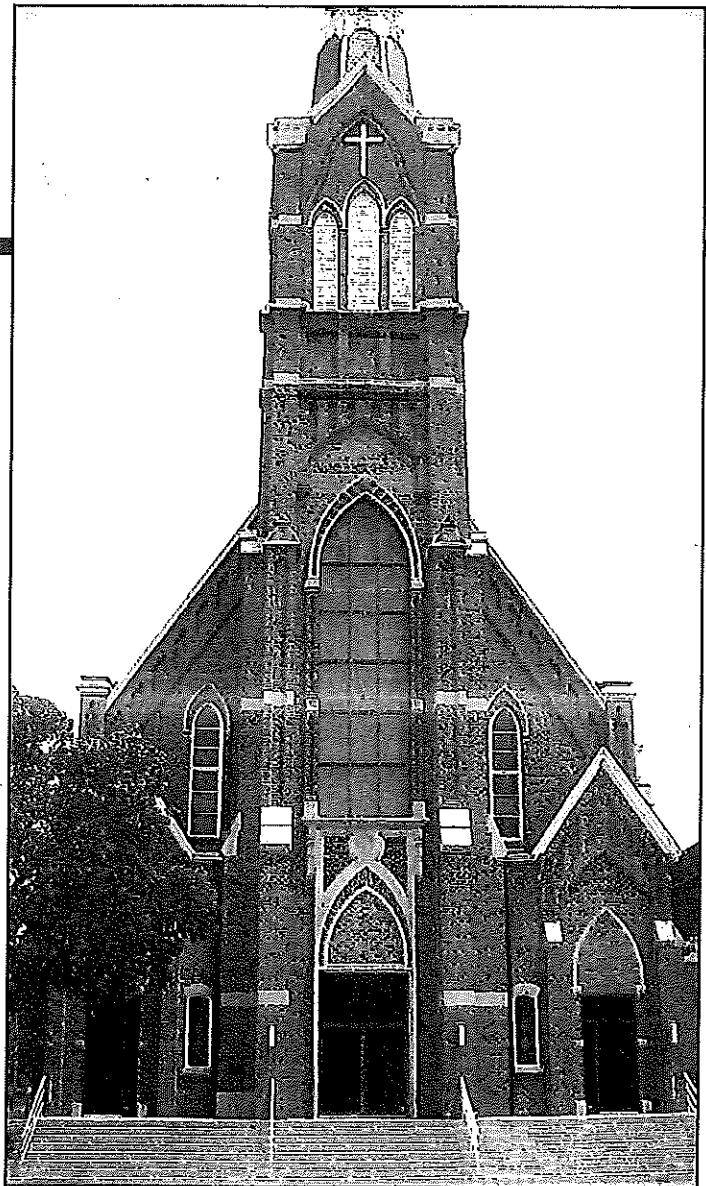

Teaching... and Learning...

This weekend we hear how Jesus teaches us about the "Kingdom of God". Yes, our eternal hope. His words bring everlasting life; as we ponder these words, we pray that we will be strengthened on our journey. What do we hear, and what do we receive? In the biblical context, the concepts of "hearing" and "living" are deeply intertwined, reflecting the relationship between obedience to God's Word and the experience of abundant life. The Scriptures emphasize that true life is found in listening to and following the divine instructions provided by God. Hearing, in the biblical sense, goes beyond the mere auditory reception of sound. It involves a deep, attentive listening that leads to understanding and obedience. It begins with the command to "hear": "**Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is One**" (Deuteronomy 6:4). This call to hear is not just about listening but about responding to God's revelation with faith and action.

Just last weekend we heard Jesus calling his first disciples: Simon Peter, James, and John. Today we hear him talking to a much larger crowd, but also, in Luke's Gospel he was looking at his disciples when he spoke. Typical in a classroom the teacher is speaking to the whole class while focusing maybe on a particular student or two. The more we hear the better we live it the better the reward. Success is in what we hear and how we apply it each day of our lives.

God has a call, yes, because he is the master architect, and we come to recognize his voice... then we come to understand him more fully and what he is saying. *Just get out of the boat* and not be afraid to follow him. St. Paul reminds us that our belief in the resurrection gives us the hope that we may live eternally in the kingdom of God. Jesus himself lived a life involving much grief, and strong opposition, which eventually led to his execution. "*His reward is indeed great in Heaven.*" That reward is now our reward, for he has won for us our salvation.

The Question: What about my life is Jesus calling me to change so that I may be blessed, what can I do to be truly blessed? - Fr. Jerry

Diocese of Toledo Snow Emergency Policy

With the winter season upon us, please keep in mind the policy for Level 3 Snow Emergencies, established in 2014: "Whenever a county/city within the Diocese of Toledo is placed under a Level 3 Snow Emergency, during which all roadways are closed to non-emergency personnel, the Catholic Churches within that geographic region will cancel the scheduled Saturday Vigil, Sunday, or Holy Day Masses. Roman Catholics in that region, therefore, are dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass. If Masses are cancelled, Catholics are encouraged to participate in Holy Mass via television, radio, or internet, making a spiritual Communion. When Mass is cancelled, all other diocesan, parish, or school events in that geographic region are also cancelled." People should always use prudential judgment when traveling. Stay safe and warm.

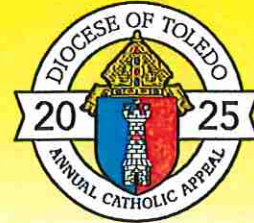

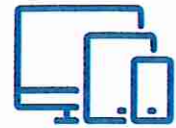

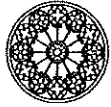
