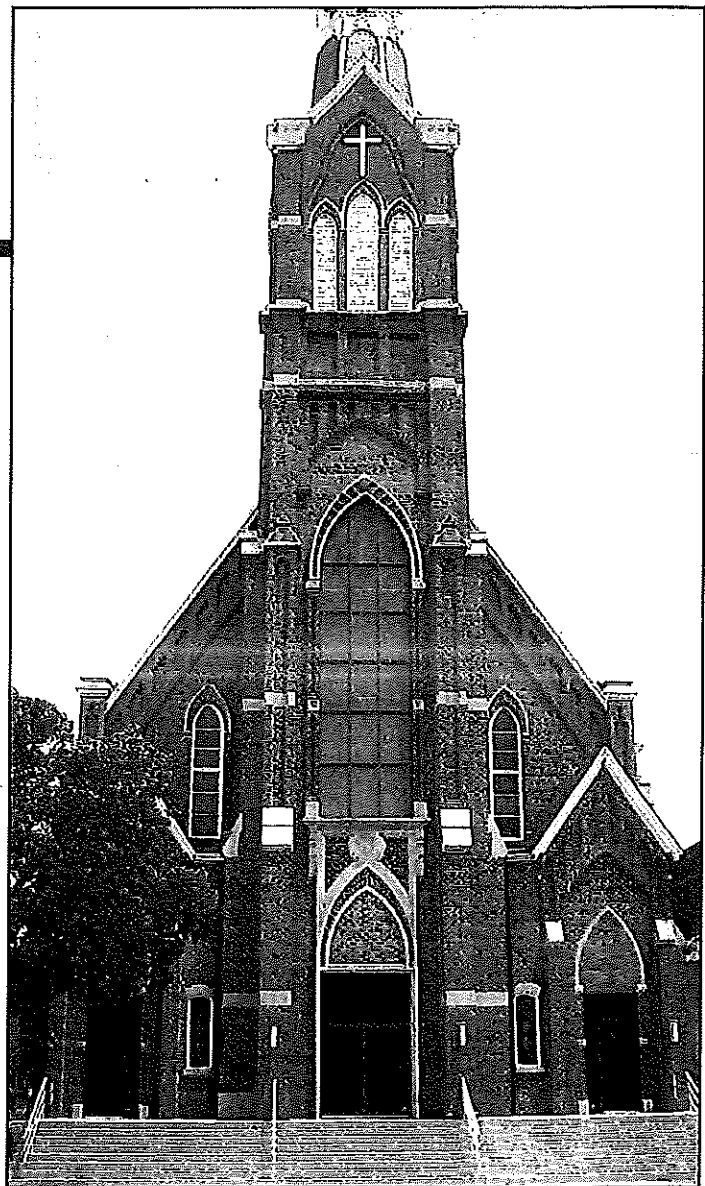

LENTEN OBLIGATIONS - On ASH WEDNESDAY, March 5 and GOOD FRIDAY, April 18, fast and abstinence from eating meat is to be observed.

ALL FRIDAYS of Lent are penitential days, in which abstinence from eating meat is to be observed.

OBLIGATIONS OF ABSTINENCE AND FAST: All persons 14 and over are bound by the law of abstinence. All those 18 and over are bound by the law of fast up to age 59, inclusive.

In observing the precept of FAST one small meal and two smaller meals may be taken. Taking medicine does not break one's fast.

REFLECTION ON LENTEN FASTING: If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of Jesus, and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate His Resurrection.

Dear Parish Community,

I have some exciting news to share how you can redirect some of your State of Ohio income tax dollars to St. Augustine Catholic School! Rather than pay the State of Ohio the income tax money they are due each year, the State allows Ohio residents to give some of that tax money directly to St. Augustine Catholic School, to help pay for scholarships, benefiting our students!

How it Works: As a State of Ohio taxpayer, you can claim a tax credit up to \$750 as single or \$1500 married, filing jointly. Any amount you donate up to these limits to St. Augustine Catholic School can be subtracted from the amount you pay to the State of Ohio when filing your taxes.

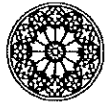
