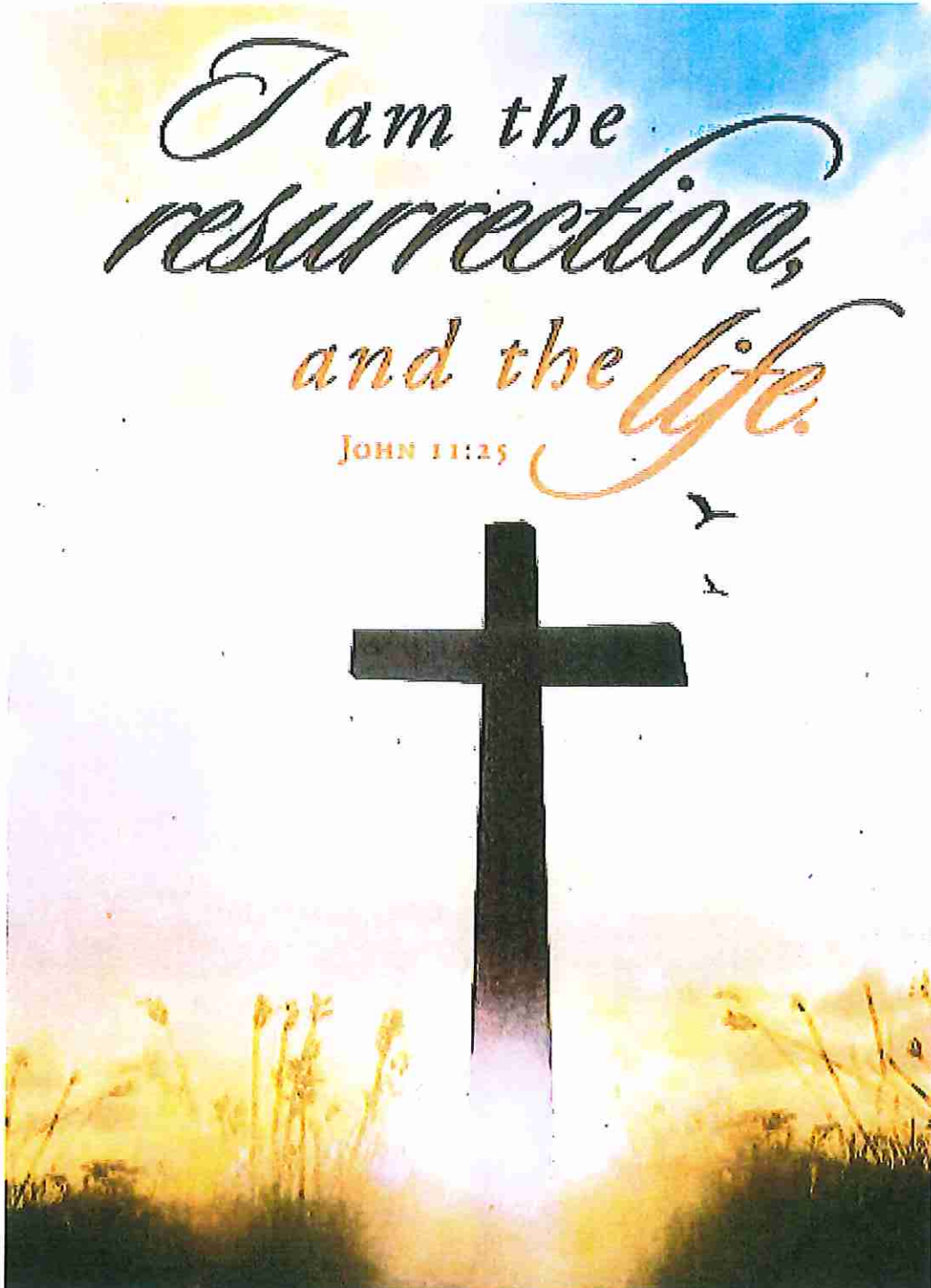

## ***The Empty Tomb...***

Easter Sunday marks the most pivotal moment in Christian faith—the Resurrection of Jesus Christ. After His crucifixion and burial, something extraordinary happened on that Sunday morning nearly two thousand years ago that forever changed the course of human history. The empty tomb discovered by His followers wasn't just an unexpected twist in the story. It was the fulfillment of prophecy and the cornerstone upon which Christianity was built. When the stone was rolled away and the burial clothes were found without a body, a new chapter of hope began. Understanding what truly occurred on that first Easter Sunday helps believers grasp the foundation of their faith. The resurrection isn't merely a historical claim but the central promise that continues to transform lives today through the power of new life. The resurrection of Jesus Christ stands as the cornerstone of Christian faith, meticulously documented in all four gospels. Each gospel writer captures unique details while maintaining agreement on the essential facts of that transformative Sunday morning.

The sequence of events unfolded rapidly: **Before sunrise** – Women prepare spices and head to the tomb (Mark 16:1-2) **Dawn** – Earthquake occurs, angel rolls away the stone (Matthew 28:2-4) **Early morning** – Women arrive to find the stone removed (Luke 24:1-3) **Morning** – Peter and John run to investigate the empty tomb (John 20:3-9) **Later morning** – Jesus appears to Mary Magdalene (John 20:11-18) **Afternoon** – Jesus appears to disciples on road to Emmaus (Luke 24:13-35) **Evening** – Jesus appears to gathered disciples (Luke 24:36-43) It took all four gospels to give a deeper understanding of all that happened that Easter Morning! The Resurrection of our Lord... the great ALLELUIA!

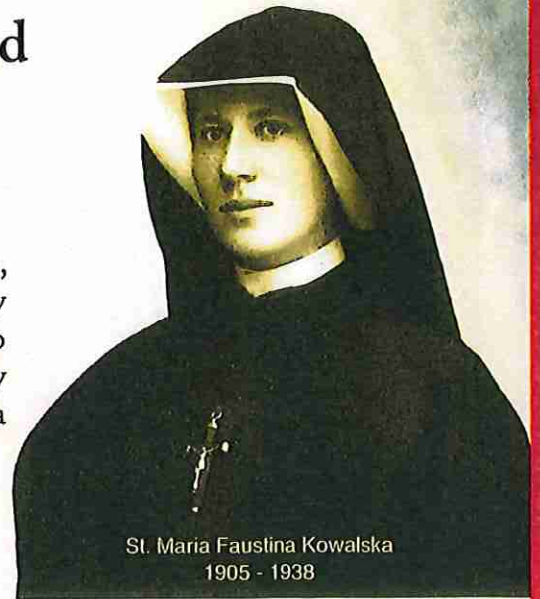

# The Feast of Mercy

## A Day of Extraordinary Grace for the Entire World

*"I desire that the first Sunday after Easter  
be the Feast of Mercy."* Jesus to St. Faustina

In a series of revelations to Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska in the 1930s, our Lord repeatedly called for the celebration of the Feast of Mercy on the first Sunday after Easter. He promised an ocean of graces to be poured upon the world. Today, we know this feast as Divine Mercy Sunday, named by St. John Paul II at the canonization of St. Faustina on April 30, 2000.

*"No soul that has called upon My mercy has ever been  
disappointed or brought to shame."*

"Ordinarily, only the sacrament of Baptism effects in the soul the 'complete forgiveness of sins and punishment.' Reception of the Eucharist in a state of grace ordinarily remits only venial sin, while strengthening the soul against both venial and mortal sin (Catechism, 1394-1395). But on Mercy Sunday reception of Holy Communion worthily and with trust in God's Mercy pours out upon the soul a complete renewal of baptismal grace." - Rev. Ignacy Rozycki, STD, Former Member of the Holy See's International Theological Commission

*"My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet."*



### How to Receive the Graces of Divine Mercy Sunday

Every family needs God's mercy. Lenten prayers, fasting, alms giving, and works of mercy help us prepare well for extraordinary graces on Feast of Mercy.

- Celebrate the Feast on Divine Mercy Sunday
- Repent of all sins and place complete trust in Jesus
- Go to Confession, preferably before that Sunday.
- Receive Holy Communion worthily on that day (or the Vigil celebration.)
- Venerate the Image of Divine Mercy
- Be merciful to others in deed, word, and prayer

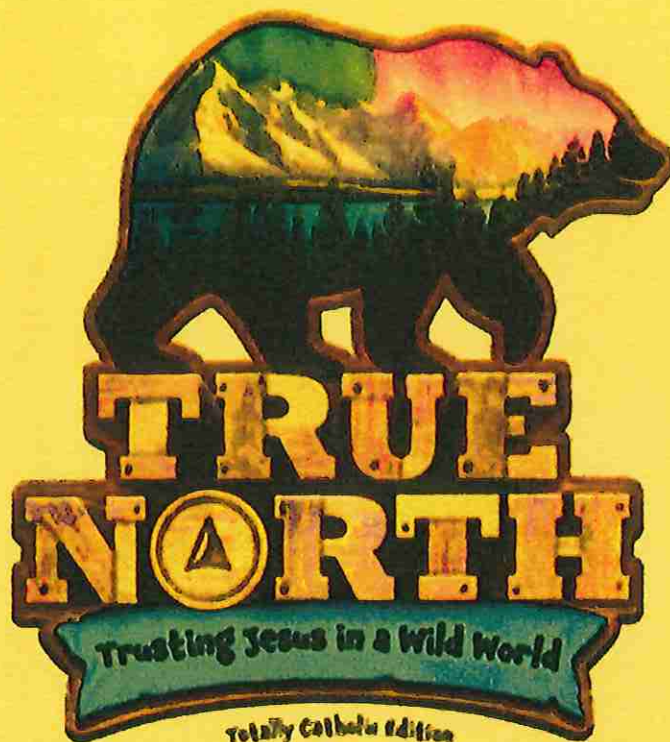


