CANCELLATIONS AND DELAYS

A Digital Academy message will also be made by 6:35 am. This is the time of year when we could have fog. **If there is a delay, Morning-Care begins at 9:00 a.m.**

HEALTH RECORDS

The Henry County Health Department Nurse will visit our building on September 9th and 10th. She will screen students in preschool through 8th grade in vision and hearing. Older students will also be screened for scoliosis. At this time, she will review all student health records. If we find that we are missing anything from your child(ren)'s health records we will advise you. Receiving this information from you asap will be greatly appreciated in preparation for her visit!

DENTAL PREVENTION PROGRAM

We have been given the opportunity to participate in free dental services. The Dental Outreach program will visit our school for exams on March 24 and May 11, 2026. Please review the enclosed flier and complete the attached consent form if you are interested. These forms are due by September 17th, so please return them in the parent folder next week.

FREE/REDUCED LUNCH APPLICATION

We have enclosed a Free and Reduced Lunch application. If you think that you may qualify, you would be doing us a favor by completing this form. Besides receiving assistance in paying for your child's lunch, we receive additional funds for the purchase of student services throughout the year. Students who were on Free or Reduced lunches last year still qualify this year until September 12th, so please fill it out to see if your child still qualifies. Remember, since we no longer participate in the government lunch program, "free" lunches cost \$1.00, and "reduced" lunches cost \$1.50.
