

## Getting Fed...

*The "Word of God" refers to the Bible & the message of Jesus Christ, embodying divine word and guidance for believers. The Word, became Flesh and dwelled among us.*

In Christianity, the term "*Word of God*" holds profound significance. It truly encompasses both the scripture and the person of Jesus Christ. The Bible is considered the written revelation of God's will and character, often referred to as the "*Word of God*" due to its divine origin and authority. As stated in 2 Timothy 3:16, "All Scripture is God Breathed... and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness." We are guided by faith and practiced in life. Catholic Education is the embodiment of God's Word in teaching our children God's Holy truth.

A little anecdote... There was in Paris these four employees who approached their Christian employer to receive their usual New Year's gifts. "*Well, my friends,*" said the employer, "*Here are your gifts, you may choose fifteen francs or the Bible.*" The first said, "*I don't know how to read, so I'll take the 15 francs.*" The second said, he too would take the francs, he had pressing needs. The third also made the same decision. Next came the fourth, a young man, new to the company. He observed and said, I heard the book is good, I will take it and read from it every day. As he was reading through the book, he found two gold francs worth 40 francs each. The others hung their heads, and the Christian employer told them he was sorry the rest of them had not made a *better* choice.

You know it has been said that the Bible is the most popular and important book sold... but the least read book. When we choose to read the Bible, to make it our own, the treasure lies within its pages and we find the true treasure... God's inspired words... We receive our just goodness. Yes, as St. Paul advises Timothy; "*All scripture is inspired by God and is useful for teaching so as to equip one with everything he needs.*" If we apply the greatest gift we can receive, our treasures will be in the pages we read, the gold will be made available to us. – Fr. ## KEEPING SUNDAYS HOLY!

The modern, technology-driven life is so busy. The week is barely long enough for all the mundane activities that must be done. Sometimes, the work week even encroaches upon Sunday's rights: yes, a morning slot is set aside for Mass while the rest of Sunday whirls past just like the other days in the week. How can we stop the busyness and truly focus on Sunday ...the Lord's Day? How can we extend our God-oriented frame of mind beyond Sunday Mass? How can we "*keep holy the Sabbath*"? Well, there are many ways of observing the Lord's Day in a fitting manner. We know what we *shouldn't* do; let's look at **what we should**.

Some family time is a great thing to add to your Sunday! The Catechism says: On Sundays and other holy days of obligation, the faithful are to refrain from engaging in work or activities that hinder the worship owed to God, the joy proper to the Lord's day, the performance of the works of mercy, and the appropriate relaxation of mind and body. - CCC no.2185 Now, this looks like a "don't"- **but look closer**. You'll see that this passage tells what we *can* (and ought to) do on Sundays: worship God, be joyful, perform works of mercy, and rest both mind and body. Is that really that hard...**NO!**

**TOLEDO DIOCESE SNOW EMERGENCY POLICY** With the winter season upon us, please keep in mind the policy for Level 3 Snow Emergencies, established in 2014: "Whenever a county/city within the Diocese of Toledo is placed under a Level 3 Snow Emergency, during which all roadways are closed to non-emergency personnel, the Catholic Churches within that geographic region will cancel the scheduled Saturday Vigil, Sunday, or Holy Day Masses. Roman Catholics in that region, therefore, are dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass. If Masses are cancelled, Catholics are encouraged to participate in Holy Mass via television, radio, or internet, making a spiritual Communion. When Mass is cancelled, all other diocesan, parish, or school events in that geographic region are also cancelled." People should always use prudential judgment when traveling. Stay safe and warm.

Now entering its 52nd year, Catholic Schools Week will be celebrated from January 25-30, 2026. This year's theme, "Catholic Schools: United in Faith and Community," highlights our shared mission of forming students who love God and neighbor, serve others, and grow as responsible citizens of the world. Catholic schools are known for academic excellence intentionally directed toward the growth of the whole child—mind, body, and spirit. Rooted in faith and service, Catholic education enriches society by forming disciples who live out their faith through learning, leadership, and service to others.

Did you know that a Catholic Education is affordable for everyone! All families in the State of Ohio are eligible to receive a scholarship to attend St. Augustine School. The EdChoice Expansion Scholarship window will open in February for the 2026-27 school year for children entering Kindergarten through 8th Grade. We will begin registration for the next school year at the beginning of February. Please call the school office if you have any questions.

If you pay Ohio State income taxes, you have a wonderful opportunity to choose where a portion of those dollars goes. Rather than sending your tax dollars to the State of Ohio, the state allows eligible taxpayers to direct some of that money to support St. Augustine Catholic School, helping to provide scholarships that directly benefit our students. Ohio taxpayers may receive a tax credit of up to \$750 for individuals or \$1,500 for married couples filing jointly. Any qualifying donation, up to these limits, can be credited against the amount you owe the State of Ohio this year when you donate before filing your taxes on April 15, 2026.
