

## Getting Fed...

*The "Word of God" refers to the Bible & the message of Jesus Christ, embodying divine word and guidance for believers. The Word, became Flesh and dwelled among us.*

In Christianity, the term "*Word of God*" holds profound significance. It truly encompasses both the scripture and the person of Jesus Christ. The Bible is considered the written revelation of God's will and character, often referred to as the "*Word of God*" due to its divine origin and authority. As stated in 2 Timothy 3:16, "All Scripture is God Breathed... and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness." We are guided by faith and practiced in life. Catholic Education is the embodiment of God's Word in teaching our children God's Holy truth.

A little anecdote... There was in Paris these four employees who approached their Christian employer to receive their usual New Year's gifts. "*Well, my friends,*" said the employer, "*Here are your gifts, you may choose fifteen francs or the Bible.*" The first said, "*I don't know how to read, so I'll take the 15 francs.*" The second said, he too would take the francs, he had pressing needs. The third also made the same decision. Next came the fourth, a young man, new to the company. He observed and said, I heard the book is good, I will take it and read from it every day. As he was reading through the book, he found two gold francs worth 40 francs each. The others hung their heads, and the Christian employer told them he was sorry the rest of them had not made a *better* choice.

You know it has been said that the Bible is the most popular and important book sold... but the least read book. When we choose to read the Bible, to make it our own, the treasure lies within its pages and we find the true treasure... God's inspired words... We receive our just goodness. Yes, as St. Paul advises Timothy; "*All scripture is inspired by God and is useful for teaching so as to equip one with everything he needs.*" If we apply the greatest gift we can receive, our treasures will be in the pages we read, the gold will be made available to us. — Fr. Jerry

He sets aside the first to establish the second. And by that will, we have been made holy through the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ once for all. It expresses the ideal condition of how our will should be, a tremendous challenge for all of us since we have the strong tendency to make our will exclusively as our own. If ever we concede to the will of another, it is mainly for our own convenience or advantage which in the end is just doing our own will.

We need to learn to live by God's will which is what is most important to us. It's not just following our will which is, of course, indispensable to us. Otherwise, we would be undermining our very own freedom and our humanity itself. Whatever we do is done because we want it. It should be a fruit of our freedom.

What God wants most of us is our love. There are no academic requirements to live a life of holiness... hence we are all Saints in the Making. The only requirement is to trust in God and allow God to do with us whatever he desires. What is most important is to conform our will to God's will, which is even more indispensable to us. Otherwise, we sooner or later would destroy our freedom and our humanity itself, since God is the very author and the very lawgiver of our freedom and our humanity.

This is a basic truth that we need to spread around more widely and abidingly, since it is steadily and even systematically forgotten and, nowadays, even contradicted in many instances. We need to inculcate this truth to children as early as when they can understand and appreciate it. Then let's give them the example of how it is lived.

God's will is the source of everything in the universe. The whole of creation in all its existence, unity, truth, goodness and beauty starts from God's will and is maintained by it. May our will be conformed to His Holy Will.

Did you know that a Catholic Education is affordable for everyone! All families in the State of Ohio are eligible to receive a scholarship to attend St. Augustine School. The EdChoice Expansion Scholarship window will open in February for the 2026-27 school year for children entering Kindergarten through 8th Grade. We will begin registration for the next school year at the beginning of February. Please call the school office if you have any questions.

If you pay Ohio State income taxes, you have a wonderful opportunity to choose where a portion of those dollars goes. Rather than sending your tax dollars to the State of Ohio, the state allows eligible taxpayers to direct some of that money to support St. Augustine Catholic School, helping to provide scholarships that directly benefit our students. Ohio taxpayers may receive a tax credit of up to \$750 for individuals or \$1,500 for married couples filing jointly. Any qualifying donation, up to these limits, can be credited against the amount you owe the State of Ohio this year when you donate before filing your taxes on April 15, 2026.
