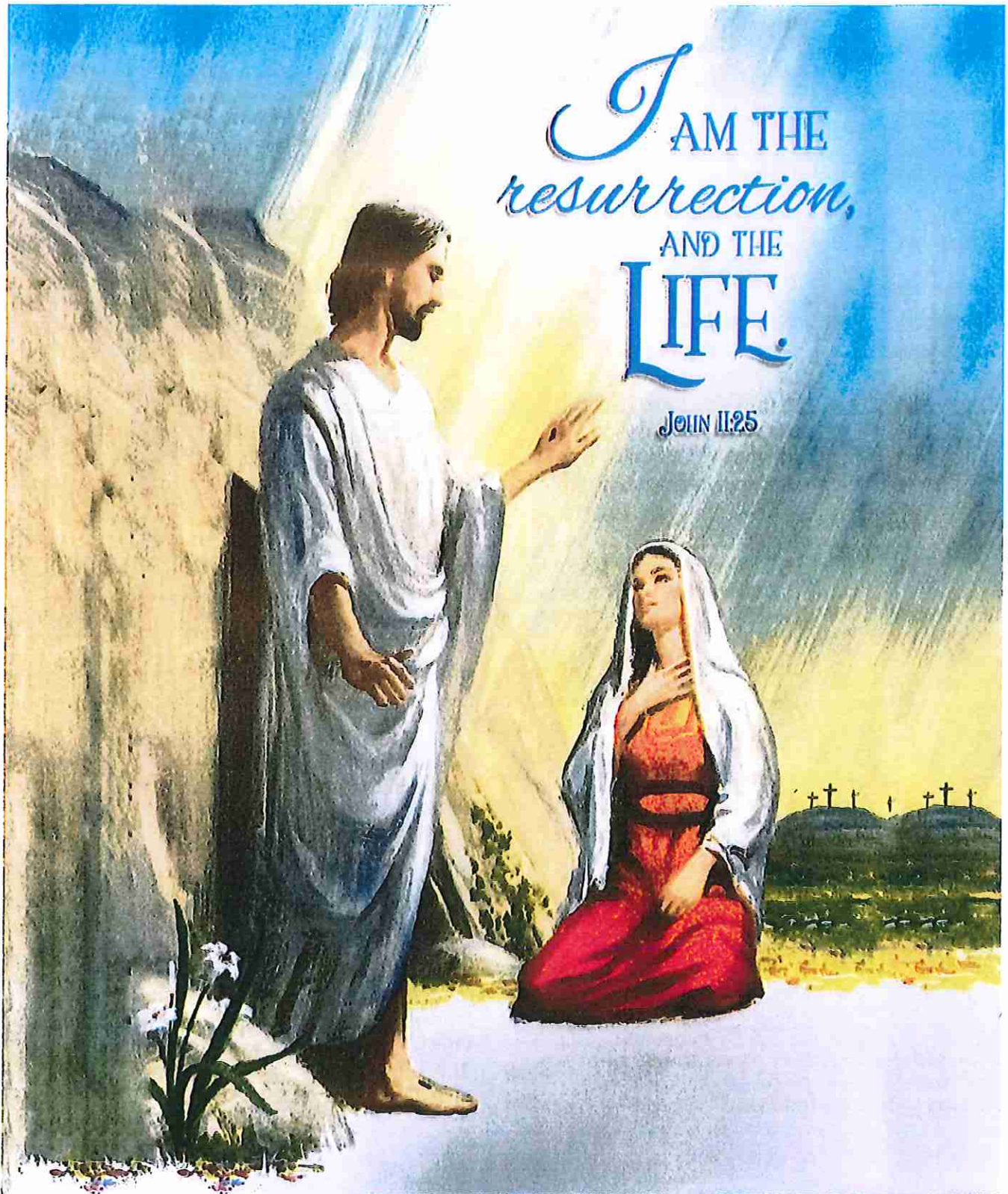



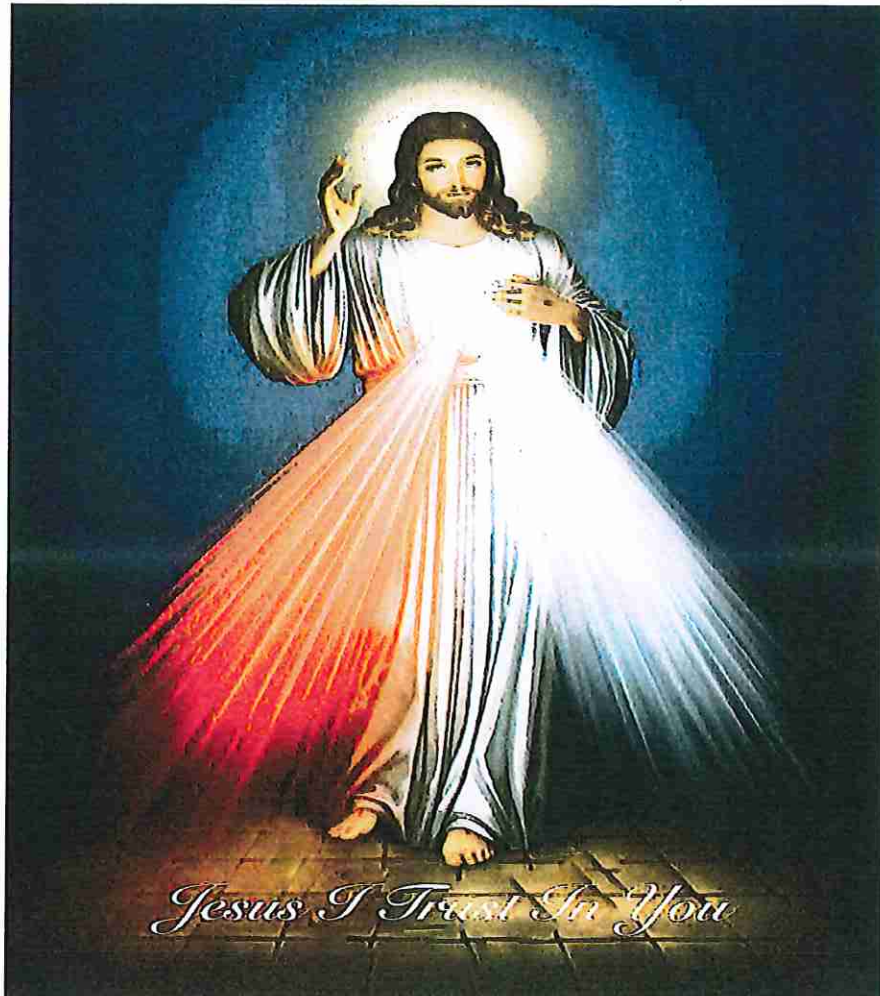
Project Welcome Baby seeking expecting Mom's/ Parents

Divine Mercy Sunday

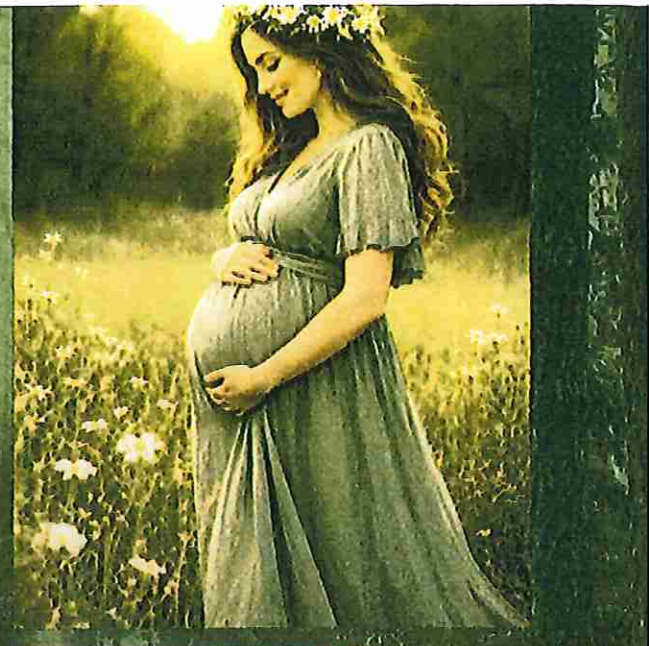
