2026-27 SCHOOL REGISTRATION

We continue registering students exclusively on Digital Academy for the 2026-27 school year. If you are having trouble logging in or with the registration process, please call the office. We are moving toward an online-only operating system, so we encourage you to become familiar with it.

Students entering Kindergarten - 8th Grade are eligible to receive an EdChoice Scholarship. Scholarship forms were sent home. If your student received an EdChoice Expansion Scholarship in our

current school year, you are only required to fill out the EdChoice Scholarship Program Renewal Form and supply a current utility or gas bill that includes both the Mailing Address and Service Address.

Income verification is not required to renew the EdChoice Scholarship. Families may qualify for low-income status if they choose to have their income verified. Please contact Mrs. Minnick with any questions.
