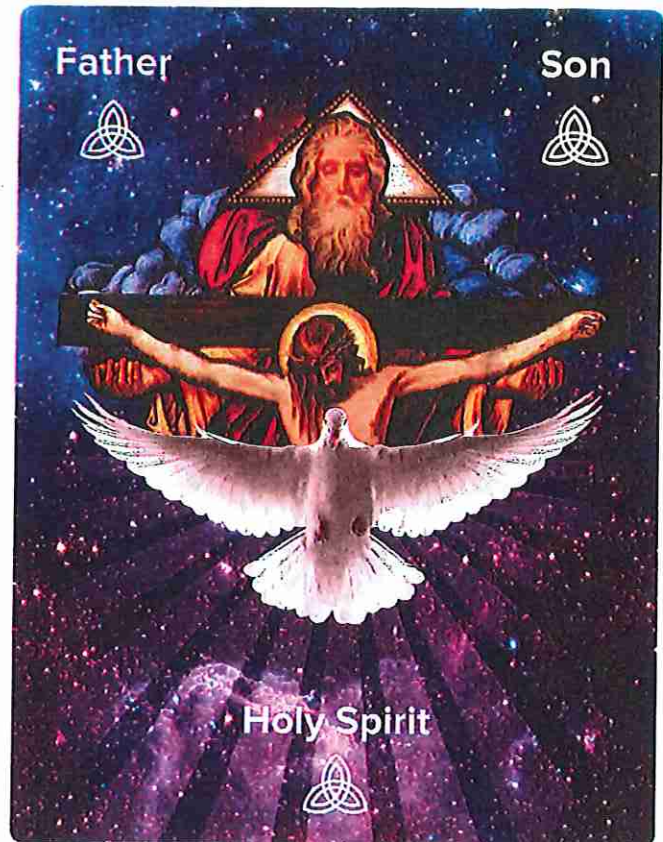

The website of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) has a wonderful resource page for the upcoming Consecration of our Nation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus (<https://www.usccb.org/consecration-united-states-sacred-heart-jesus>). Archbishop Alexander K. Sample, Archbishop of Portland, Oregon and Chairman of the Committee for Religious Liberty offers a reflection on the Consecration to the Sacred Heart. He writes: "With his encyclical, *Dilexit Nos*, Pope Francis noted: 'In contemplating the pierced heart of the Lord, who 'took our infirmities and bore our diseases,' we too are inspired to be more attentive to the sufferings and needs of others and confirmed in our efforts to share in his work of liberation as instruments for the spread of his love.' In *Dilexi Te*, Pope Leo invited us to contemplate Christ's love, which moves us out on our mission to attend to our sisters and brothers suffering in the world today, particularly in our care for poor and vulnerable people. As we reflect with gratitude on the blessings God has bestowed on our country, our devotion to the Sacred Heart demands that we consider how we might foster truth, justice, and charity in American life. We welcome God's 'kingdom of justice, fraternity and solidarity,' remembering that 'God has a special place in his heart for those who are discriminated against and oppressed, and he asks us, his Church, to make a decisive and radical choice in favor of the weakest.' This anniversary and consecration will be a great opportunity to promote the beautiful devotion to the Sacred Heart and to encourage the laity to offer their lives in service to God and their country." Please consider the various ways to celebrate Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, especially the Novena that begins on June 3rd.

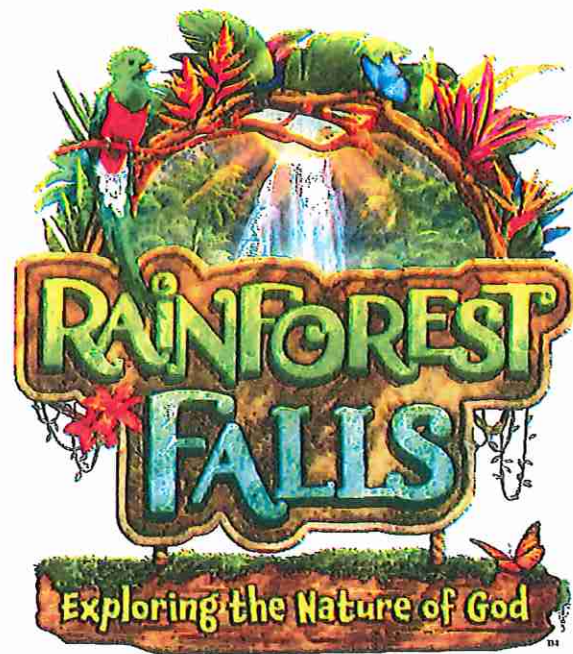

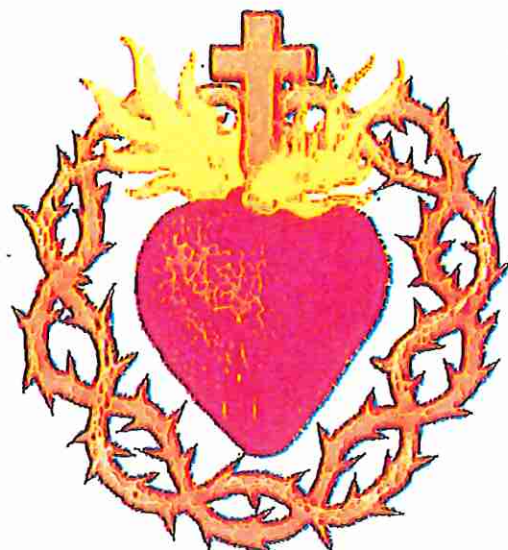
