"Saints in the Making" ★★★★★ "Living and Sharing our Faith"

Besides the times of the year around the great feasts of Christmas and Easter, there remains in the yearly cycle 33 or 34 weeks in which no particular aspect of the mystery of Christ is celebrated, but rather the mystery of Christ itself is honored in its fullness, especially on Sundays. This season is called "Ordinary Time." The word "ordinary" as used here comes from the ordinal numerals by which the weeks are identified or counted, from the 1st week of Ordinary Time in January to the 34th week that begins toward the end of November. Green is the liturgical color of Ordinary Time because it is the color of life and hope. Ordinary Time is divided into two time periods. Following the Baptism of our Lord until Ash Wednesday and after Pentecost Sunday until the Advent season begins again. The final Sunday in Ordinary Time is the feast of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, traditionally called the feast of Christ the King. This season of Ordinary Time that occurs in the warmer months may prompt us to link our daily prayers with the enjoyment of nature: pray outdoors when taking a walk, plant a flower/garden and watch it grow, wake up early and enjoy the sunrise using Morning Prayer or attending daily Mass, make time for family prayer time, especially on vacation. As the plants grow and bloom during these summer months, let us take the chance to grow in our faith!
