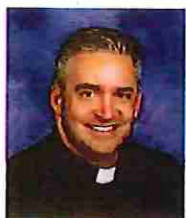

It is a joy and blessing to serve you as your Pastor...**GOD BLESS AMERICA!**

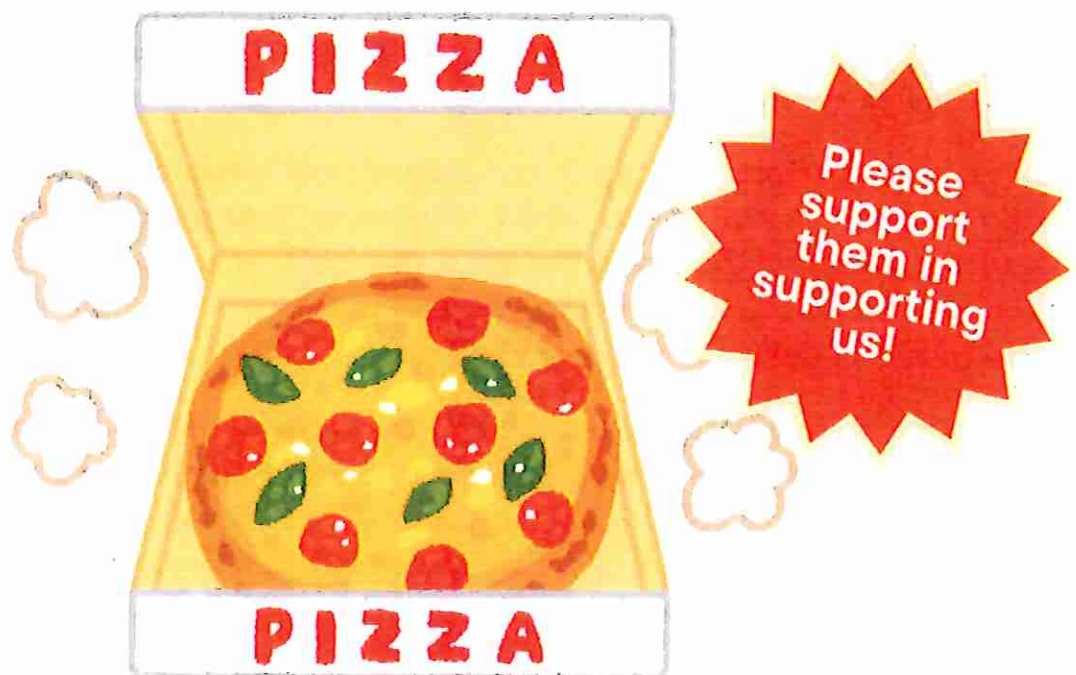

CANDLELIGHT ROSARY PROCESSION AND MASS FOR VIGIL OF THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY - to take place on Fri., Aug. 14 at 9:00 pm at the Basilica and National Shrine of Our Lady of Consolation in Carey. HUMANITARIAN EARTHQUAKE RELIEF COLLECTION FOR VENEZUELA - Our prayers go out to the people of Venezuela. Thousands are now homeless suffering from the widespread destruction wrought by the deadliest earthquake to hit the country since 1900.
